Numerous studies have shown that what distinguishes outstanding leaders from average ones are emotional self-awareness and self-control.

"Emotional intelligence is the ability to understand your own and others' emotions and how they drive behavior, and then using that knowledge to motivate others.

"Most people make mistakes around emotional intelligence because they don't understand what's going on with other people," says Travis Bradberry, president of TalentSmart in San Diego, which provides emotional intelligence tests and training. "They don't even necessarily understand what's going on with themselves."

In assessments of more than 2 million workers, TalentSmart researchers found that "just 36 percent of people are able to accurately identify their emotions as they happen."
