SKILLS AREN'T SOFT OR HARD—THEY'RE DURABLE OR PERISHABLE

The term "soft skills" is often met with an eye-roll these days. It is regularly delivered with air quotes to acknowledge that most of us have come to hate the expression.

Research suggests that skills generally have a "half-life" of about five years, with the more technical skills at just two and a half years. Business leaders and learners need a completely new model for thinking about skills, a model that fosters thinking about emerging questions:

 Are skills more durable or more perishable?

- Are skills transferable across roles or industries?
- Are skills in demand, and will they be in the future?

What kind of skills fall into that perishable bucket? Tech skills, especially those related to a specific vendor, platform or programming language that are updated frequently. Organizational policies are also highly perishable—frequently shifting with initiatives and leadership. If team members are only trained on perishable skills—such as how to use

the latest process, we're ultimately limiting how effective talent can move between roles.

Durable skills look at various attributes required to interact with others and be successful in the workplace. Skills such as teamwork, collaboration, negotiation, critical thinking, initiative, risk-taking, creativity, adaptability, leadership, cognitive flexibility and problem-solving to name a few.

Are managers being trained to update those 40-year-old hiring practices and begin hiring for the future? That can start today by seeking out and developing those skills that will be most in-demand in the future.



- Reduced tuition rate. Employees of organizations who are affiliated with the Center for Financial Training & Education Alliance (CFTEA) will qualify for our reduced, partnership tuition rate for all online, for-credit courses. This reduction amounts to an approximate 15% savings.
- What kind of online programs do we offer?
 - BSBA with a Banking major -- Saint Joseph's College offers a unique and relevant-to-you online Bachelor's of Science program in Business Administration with a Banking major. If you have not yet earned your Bachelor's degree, this could be a great option for you! The Banking major in our Business program consists of CFTEA courses - meaning if you've taken classes through CFTEA before, you may already have credit that can transfer in to our program. We can also accept up to 75% of the 120 credits required in transfer, so if you've attended college before, those credits could count too!
 - MBA, Leadership MBA, and Master of Accountancy degrees -- Already have your Bachelor's? Consider earning your Master's degree online with us instead! We offer a Foundational MBA for those who have broader content interests, a Leadership MBA for those with management and executive-level career goals, and a Master of Accountancy degree if you'd like to pursue a numbers-focused career. No GMAT scores are required for admission!

- Learn online, but not alone. Saint Joe's courses let you determine the time and location of completing
 your work. With no live component for any of the degrees listed above, you can fit our structured courses
 into your busy schedule, wherever you are.
- You'll be fully supported. Your admissions counselor will assist you through the application process right
 through to your first enrollment. After that, you will be assigned a dedicated student support specialist who
 will provide guidance on course selection and act as a mentor as you complete your degree.
