CFTEA & SJC: Partners in Banking Education



- CFTEA and SJC have been partners since 2019, working together to help students grow and develop in the banking profession.
- We have created a unique version of our Bachelor of Science in Business Administration specifically for CFTEA students, with a concentration in banking.
- This program (and others) will accept CFTEA credits as transfer towards a degree.
- Additionally, students who are employed by banks which are members of CFTEA receive a special reduced tuition rate for all of their courses!





Transfer Pathways with CFTEA

- Continuing education is not the same for everyone, and there are multiple ways to be a lifelong learner.
- SJC Offers courses, certificates, and degrees that can help students achieve their goals.
- We will accept CFTEA credits in many ways, and in many programs.
- Overall, we accept a maximum of 90 credits into any undergraduate program.
 - These can be general credits, or they can all be CFTEA credits!

Courses

- -Take **any course** that we offer without applying to a degree program.
- -Multiple special topics courses available.

-Program Director Recommendation: *Business Ethics* (Community-based learning course)

Certificates

- -Complete shorter certificate programs.
- -Step further into a degree, or stop here.
- -Spotlight Certificate: Leadership of Self & Others (includes Psychology and Sociology courses)

Degrees

- -Earn an advanced degree as the next step in your career.
- -Continue further with post-graduate options.
- -Most Popular Program: *Master of Business Administration in Leadership*





Flexible Course Structure

- Start dates five times per year, with 10-week terms.
- Take 3 to 12 credits every term, based on schedule and needs.
 - o 3 to 6 per term for graduate programs.
- Complete these 100% Online programs quickly and earn a degree faster!
 - Courses and materials are accessible from anywhere at anytime.
- Many of our students work full time and have other responsibilities, but are still able to complete their program without difficulty.
- Weekly due dates, but no live requirements.
 - Students do coursework at whatever time works for them.



Affordability



- The cost of college education is a concern that is forefront in the minds of most students.
- SJC strives to keep in line with our mission and core values and provide affordable educational options to students whenever possible.
- All pricing is done per-credit, and most courses are 3 credits.
- All employees of CFTEA-member banks receive a special, reduced tuition rate as part of our partnership!

Regular Cost

Undergraduate

- -\$390 per credit.
- **-\$1170** per course.

Graduate

- -\$609 per credit.
- -\$1827 per course.


CFTEA Special Rate

- -\$331 per credit.
- -\$993 per course.

Graduate


- -\$519 per credit.

BSBA-Banking at SJC

- The curriculum was jointly developed by professionals from SJC and CFTEA.
- The program aims to provide students with sound analytical skills which are necessary to become an effective supervisor or manager in the banking industry.
- Students are intended to apply credits earned through CFTEA.
- The program requires 120 total credits:
 - o 42 General Education credits
 - 36 Core Business credits
 - 30 Banking Major credits (all must be from CFTEA)
 - o 9 Business Elective credits
 - o 3 General Elective credits.






CFTEA Transfer Courses
